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Accountability under the GDPR:

"The controller shall be responsible for, and be able to demonstrate compliance with the data protection principles".

Article 29 Working Party Opinion 3/2010 on the Principle of Accountability

Move from theory to practice



A way of encouraging data controllers to implement practical tools for effective data protection



Strengthen the role of controller and increase their responsibility



Explicitly require data controllers to implement appropriate and effective measures to put into effect the principles and obligations of data protection



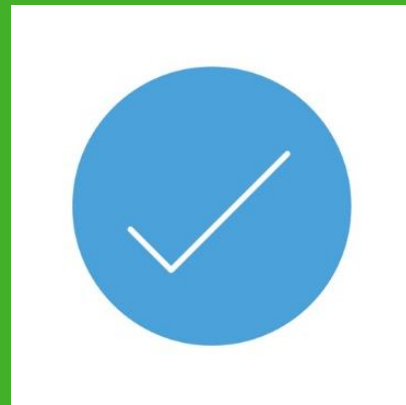
The GDPR Principles

Personal data should be:

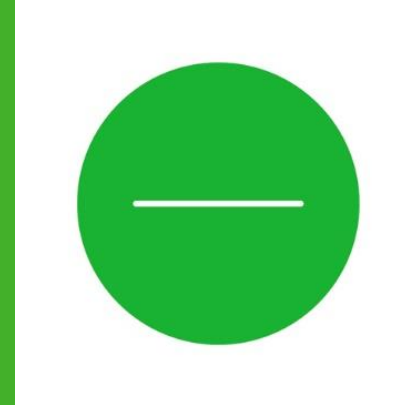
(a) processed lawfully, fairly and in a transparent manner



(b) collected for specified, explicit and legitimate purposes



(c) adequate, relevant and limited to what is necessary



(d) accurate and where necessary kept up to date



The GDPR Principles

Personal data should be:

(e) kept in a form which permits identification for no longer than necessary



(f) processed in a manner that ensures appropriate security

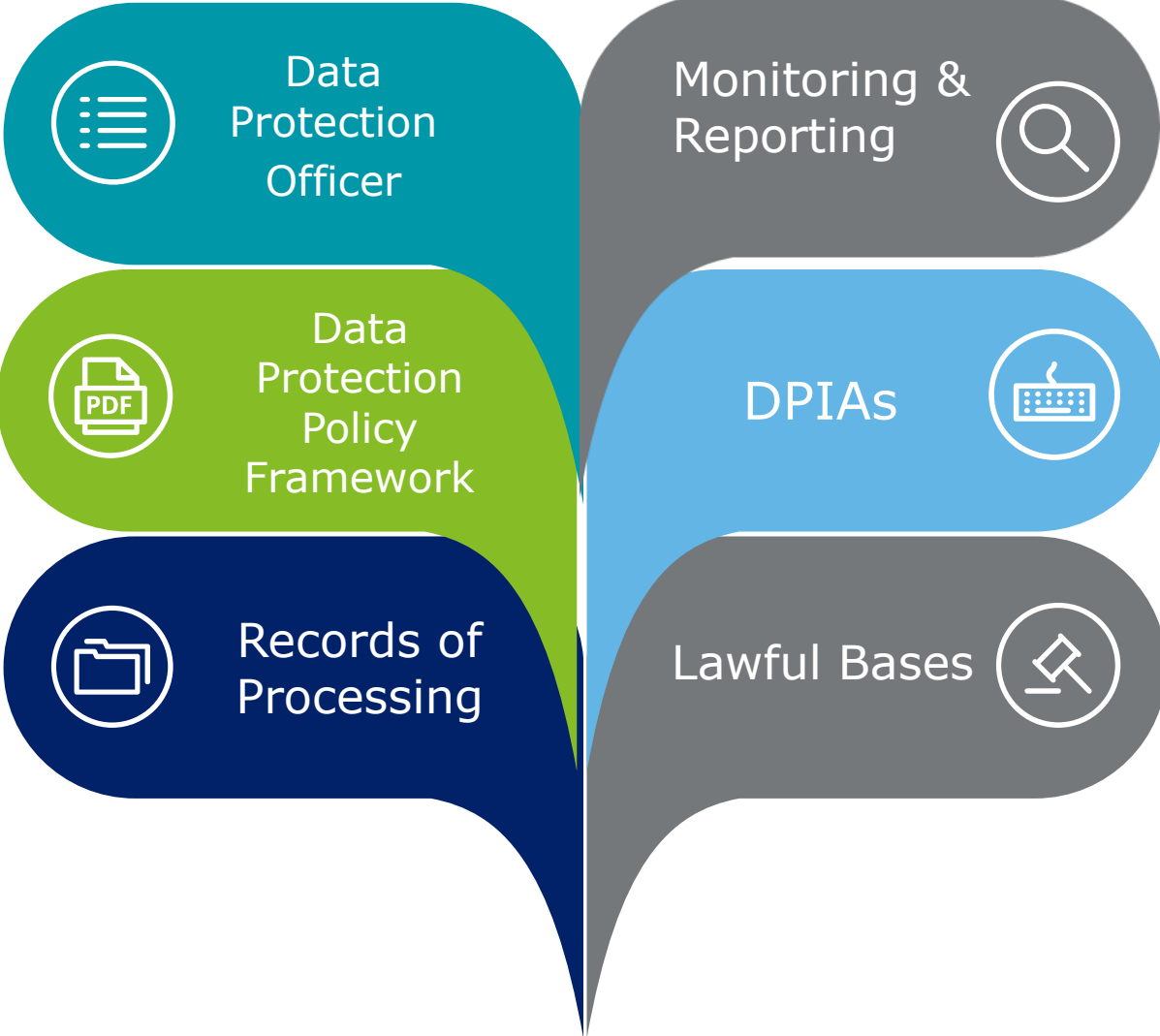


‘Accountability’

Accountability Measures



*Unless data protection becomes **part of the shared values and practices** of an organisation, and **responsibilities** for it are expressly assigned, effective compliance will be at considerable risk, and data protection mishaps are likely to continue.*
